2009 marked another successful year for the Georgia Hunters for the Hungry program by collecting 30,400 pounds of venison contributed by Georgia hunters. This year these humanitarian donations by Georgia hunters have helped feed over 150,000 meals to hungry Georgians. With additional processor locations and the increasing popularity of the “Drop-Back-A-Pack” program with hunters, hungry Georgians are being provided much needed red meat protein.
